Outdoor Art Studio – Children will enjoy complex art projects in our NEW Outdoor Art Studio! The Outdoor Art Studio is filled with many different art supplies and materials that will inspire the children to create their own masterpiece every week.

Academics – Our campers will sharpen their math, science, and reading skills through fun, interactive activities each day. Children are welcome to bring some of their own favorite books for during individual reading.
