The month of January is winter season, so we have been studying vocabulary about "el Invierno". We started our sessions with the song "El invierno llega" and listened to words that we worked with in the activities. We continued with winter clothes flash cards and a "dress the snowman" activity.

We read two books: "The Jacket I Wear in the Snow" and "winter". In both, all the vocabulary about clothes we say in Spanish: manoplas (mittens), bufanda (scarf), gorro (cap), pantalones (pants), chaqueta (jacket), sueter (sweater), calcetines (socks), and botas (boots).

Another activity for this month was to know which clothes you wear for cold or for warm weather. They had to classify different clothes as cold or warm weather. Also we played a matching game with the different clothes and their shadows.

To finish the class, they all received a mitten stamp for their good job.
