STAT (Selfless Teens Addressing the Times): encourages youth (grades 6-9) to be leaders in their community by giving them an opportunity to learn about a variety of organizations that help meet the needs of the homeless, hungry, poor, and sick, locally, nationally, and internationally.

CIT Camp: The Counselor in Training program is designed for youth ages 15-17 years who will learn about age-appropriate activities, discipline, and supervision, safety and handling emergencies, health and sanitation and parent partnerships. CIT's will be paired with a group of campers along with a Clubhouse counselor who will monitor and mentor them throughout the week. CIT's will be responsible for following their counselor's directions while assisting with a group of campers.
