Mildly Ill Care at Bright Horizons

Our mildly ill care program is available for children who are mildly ill or have injuries that prevent attendance at their regular provider. This program is available for infants through 12 years old with completed paperwork and current immunization records.

We will accept:

- Children with ear infections, sore throats, diarrhea, vomiting, asthma, viral respiratory infections including colds and pneumonia, bladder and kidney infections and skin infections
- Children with strep throat and pink eye

We cannot accept children who have highly contagious illnesses such as measles, mumps, hepatitis or lice.

Food – Bright Horizons provides morning snack, lunch and a mid-afternoon snack. Baby food and special diet food must be provided by parent/guardian.

Clothing - Children may wear comfortable play or sleep attire. Parent/guardian must provide a change of clothes (clearly labeled with child's name) and disposable diapers and wipes.

Toys — Bright Horizons provides toys, books and games. However, if your child has a favorite toy or other “security” item, you may bring it along. Please remember to label it clearly with your child's name.

Medication — Bright Horizons staff will administer medication provided by the parent/ guardian under the following conditions:

- Medications must be in original containers or packaging.
- Prescription medication labels must display child's name, date of prescription, dosage instructions and physician's name
- Non-prescription medication must be administered according to label instructions
- A parental release form for administration of medication must be signed by the child's parent/guardian

Emergencies – Bright Horizons will contact you if any serious change occurs in your child's condition. The hospital emergency department is nearby and equipped to deal with medical emergencies. We welcome calls during the day to check on your child. And, if lunch or break time allows, you are welcome to visit.

Rates & Registration - Reservations for care must be made at least one hour in advance to confirm space availability. Please call location for rates and payment details.
