Language Works-Mat Man and Letter L







This morning we created Mat Man in order to create the letter L. The children learn to recognize letters and use different skills to form letters. In this case, the children used the wooden pieces to create the L with and without using the letter card.







Using our smart board, the children used their fingers to create the letter L. The children are strengthening and refining fine motor skills needed for holding writing utensils. The children cheered on their friends as they each had a turn to create the letter.

Math Counts







The children learned to identify numerals and use 1-to-1 correspondence. They would spin a spinner and try to identify the numeral. If they were unable to identify the numeral, the children would count the spaces starting at 1 until they reached the number with the arrow. They would then take the squares from the basket and count the appropriate amount as they stacked them on the light table.
